When visiting Website and/or App for the first time, you are invited to choose which cookies you agree to be stored on your device and used further in accordance with this Cookies policy. In case of starting to use new cookies, other than strictly necessary, you will be invited to review the information on the cookies once again and to choose which cookies you agree or disagree with to be used.

FINCI reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to modify this Cookies policy. You can always find the latest version of this Cookies policy on FINCI Website/App and check it periodically for changes. If you continue to use and/or access the Website and/or App following the posting of any changes, this automatically constitutes acceptance of those changes. An updated version of this Cookies policy shall take effect upon its publishing on the Website/App.

What are cookies and similar technologies?

Cookies are small, often encrypted files of letters and numbers that are stored in browser directories or the hard drive of your computer or electronic device when you visit the website or use applications. The cookies are used to make websites and applications work more efficiently and perform certain functions, e.g., store information about your preferences, provide statistical information to us. This helps us to give you better experience when you browse and helps us to make our services better for you.

In this Cookies policy, we've explained how and why we use cookies, and what each of them do.

**FINCI uses the following types of cookies:**

- First-party cookies (FPC)- cookies stored directly by our Website and/or App. It allows us to perform useful functions that help provide good user experience.
- Third-party cookies (TPC)- cookies provided by the third parties, such as Cloudflare, Google to track website activity such as session duration, pages per session, bounce rate etc. of individuals using the webpage, along with the information on the source of the traffic.
- Strictly necessary - cookies are strictly necessary to provide you with services available and to use some of their features. Because these cookies are strictly necessary to deliver our services safely, you cannot refuse them without impacting how our website functions. You can block or delete them by changing your browser settings.

- Functional cookies - enable Website and/or App to remember information that changes the way the website behaves or looks, like your preferred language or the region that you are in. If you opt out of using these cookies, then some or all these services may not function properly.
- Analytical cookies - cookies used to count visits and traffic sources, so we can measure and improve the performance of our website. They help us know which pages are the most and least popular and see how visitors move around the site. If you decline these cookies, your visit will not be part of our statistics.
- Marketing cookies - used for user information collection to build a profile of visitor interests and then show personalized ads for that specific user. It helps us to be aware of your content preferences on the website to provide you with the most relevant information about our products and services, improve our targeting and enhance your activities on our website.
